Remember December 7.

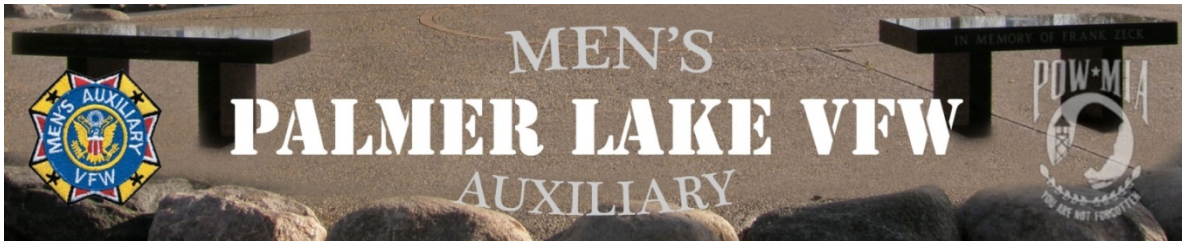
