We will be having a meeting for Christmas decorating on November 3 at 6:00 PM at the post. The more the Merrier.

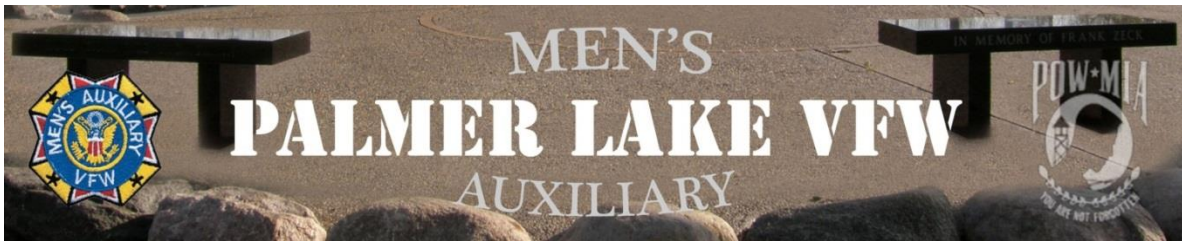
The Children’s Christmas party is planned for December 12 so just barely a month to plan and get done.
