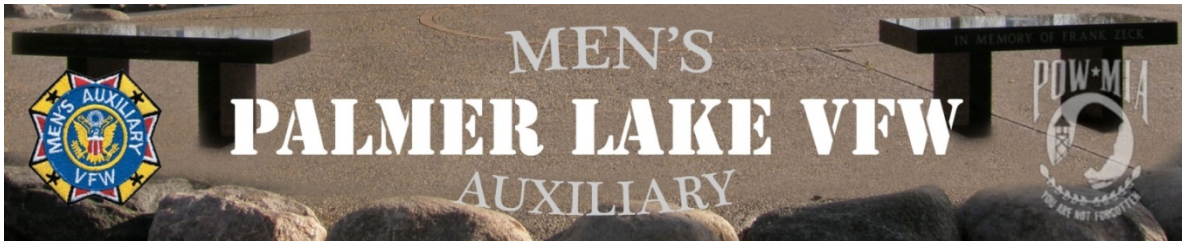
Don't forget Booya on October 11. Always a good time!!
