This year over 50,000 of our VFW members will be turning 65, making them eligible for Medicare. It's now September and our membership is at 100% plus. Thanks for your hard work and dedication troops. Job well done!

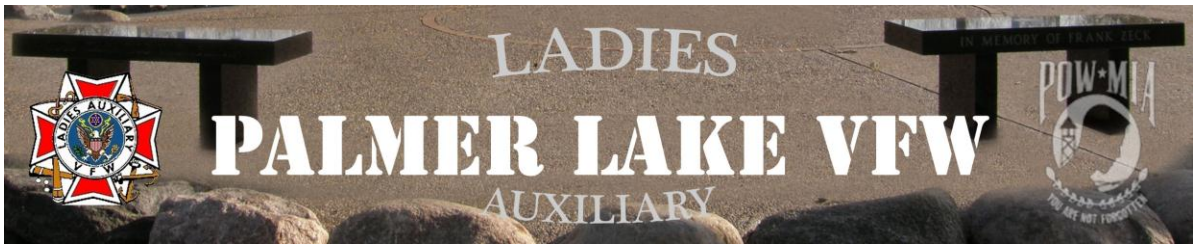
Our programs are all filled, so now we can concentrate on helping Veterans or their families. God Bless this Post!

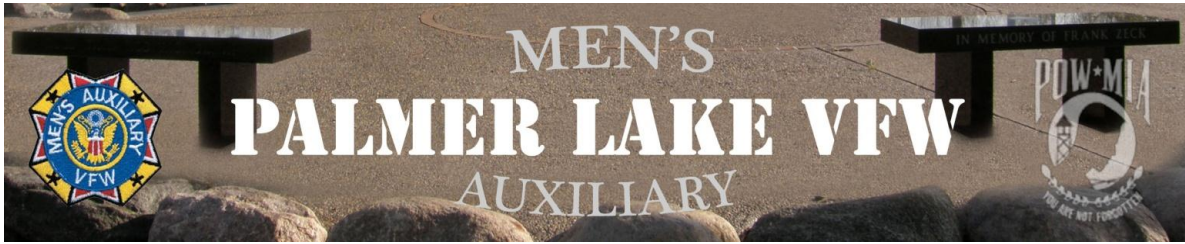


